PROPOSAL TO CHANGE LOCALITY BOUNDARIES IN CAMDEN AND CAMPBELLTOWN

The Geographical Names Board (GNB) is seeking public comment on a proposal to change existing locality boundaries within the Camden and Campbelltown Local Government Areas.

The proposal, submitted by Camden Council, is to amend the locality boundaries between Denham Court, Leppington and Varroville.

The Camden and Campbelltown Local Government boundaries were recently amended due to a large urban development taking place in the localities of Leppington and Denham Court.

The Board now needs to amend the locality boundaries to match the new local government boundaries.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Mr Mooney, said the Board is encouraging community comment before it considers adopting Council's proposal.

Copies of map GNB3568-4-A showing the proposed locality boundary amendments will be on display at the Camden Council Administration Centre located at 37 John Street, Camden and 19 Queen Street, Narellan.
