PROPOSAL TO ASSIGN A RESERVE NAME

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Liverpool City Council to name a reserve in Cecil Hills.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Narelle Underwood, said feedback is being sought on the proposal to name the site adjacent to Beatrice Street and Diana Court, *Judy Pack Park*.

Judy Pack was a dedicated volunteer historian with Liverpool City Council for over 25 years. Her assistance to the Liverpool and District Historical society was invaluable. Judy was committed to ensuring a continued history of the past is available to people of all ages.

Mrs Underwood said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community,” she said.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name.”
