PROPOSAL TO NAME A RESERVE IN ALBION PARK

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Shellharbour City Council to name a reserve in Albion Park.

Board Chair, Narelle Underwood, said feedback is being sought on the proposal to name the site located adjacent to Moles Street and Tongarra Road, Frank Smithers Park.

“It is important that the name reflects the character and history of the local area and community,” Ms Underwood said.

“Frank Smithers was an Alderman for Shellharbour City Council for 23 years, serving two years as Deputy Mayor.

“Mr Smithers was also instrumental in the development of Albion Park public swimming pool and Shellharbour Public Hospital,” she said.
