PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO SUBURB BOUNDARIES IN THE CAMDEN COUNCIL AREA

The Geographical Names Board (GNB) is seeking public comment on a proposal to change existing suburb boundaries within Camden Local Government Area.

The proposal is to amend the suburb boundaries of Narellan and Elderslie. The proposed amendment ensures planned future development in the area will not be dissected by the current suburb boundaries.

“It’s important that affected residents have their say on place names and boundary changes,” said Mrs Narelle Underwood, Chair of the Geographical Names Board.

“We invite residents to view the proposed boundary amendments and lodge submissions with the Geographical Names Board by Friday 26 January 2018.”

Copies of map GNB3568-5-A showing the proposed suburb boundary amendments will be on display at the Camden Library located at 40 John Street, Camden and the Narellan Library at the corner of Queen and Elyard Street, Narellan.
