PROPOSAL TO ASSIGN A MOUNTAIN NAME

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Lithgow City Council to name a mountain in Palmers Oaky.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Narelle Underwood, said feedback is being sought on the proposal to name *Mount Dulabree*. The site is located approximately 3.8km east of Mount Stromolo and 3.2km south west of The Big Hill, adjacent to Palmers Oaky Road.

Dulabree trigonometry (trig) station is positioned in a clearing at the top of the mountain. The mountain is well-known in the local area as Mount Dulabree due to the location of the trig station.

Mrs Underwood said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“It is important that anyone interested has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name,” she said.
