### **Proposal to assign a Reserve name – Boyds Orchard Park**

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Ku-ring-gai Council to name a reserve in Turramurra.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Narelle Underwood, said feedback is being sought on the proposal to name the site in between Allan Avenue, Duff Street and Holmes Street in the locality of Turramurra, *Boyds Orchard Park*.

The name *Boyds Orchard Park* reflects the 1893 name of the land subdivision of the area which in turn references the former land uses of the area as orchards.

Mrs Underwood said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community,” she said.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name.”
