Proposed address locality boundary amendment in Nambucca Shire Local Government Area

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Nambucca Shire Council to amend the suburb boundary between Missabotti and Spicketts Creek.

Landslides in the area restricted access to the affected properties from the south and the residents have also experienced delay in the provision of essential services. Amending the suburb boundary will support wayfinding to the properties.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Narelle Underwood said an important element of determining boundaries is endeavouring to meet the approval of affected residents and to reflect local usage.

“So that it can consider feedback, the Board is encouraging community comment before it considers adopting the proposal,” Mrs Underwood said.

A copy of map 3791-1-A, showing the proposed boundary amendment will be on display at Council’s Administration Building, 44 Princess Street, Macksville.
