## **PROPOSED CHANGES TO BEGA VALLEY LOCALITY BOUNDARIES**

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposed amendment to address boundaries between South Pambula and Greigs Flat.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Des Mooney said Bega Valley Shire Council is proposing to amend address boundaries to expand the locality of South Pambula.

“Council has confirmed the amendment will impact some properties in Greigs Flat located on the east side of the Princes Highway,” Mr Mooney said.

“Under the proposed boundary amendment, the affected properties in Greigs Flat would become residential addresses in South Pambula.

“The Geographical Names Board is encouraging community comment before it considers adopting Council’s proposal.”

Residents are invited to view the proposed boundary amendment and lodge submissions with the Geographical Names Board by Monday 8<sup>th</sup> September 2014.

A map of the Council’s proposal can be viewed at the Bega Valley Shire Council Administration Centre, Zingel Place Bega, the Bermagui Library, the Eden Library and the Merimbula Library” Mr Mooney said.
