PROPOSAL TO AMEND LOCALITY BOUNDARIES

The Geographical Names Board has received a proposal from Tweed Shire Council to amend the locality boundaries of Terranora and Banora Point within the Tweed Local Government Area.

Tweed Shire Council has approved a 256 lot residential subdivision that is currently split between the localities of Terranora and Banora Point. Council has requested to amend the locality boundaries to allow for the new development to be wholly within the locality of Terranora.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board Narelle Underwood said the Board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.
