The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Blacktown City Council to name a reserve in the district.

The late Wayne Game was a long term advocate and industry professional in the field of Work Health and Safety.

Mr Game was a passionate advocate for safety. He spent 27 years dedicated to improving safety standards across the construction industry, in particular in the residential sector of Sydney's west.

Mrs Underwood said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

"It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community," she said.

"We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name."
