PROPOSAL TO AMEND ADDRESS LOCALITY BOUNDARIES BETWEEN BENTLEY AND LARNOOK

The Geographical Names Board has received a proposal from Kyogle Council to amend address locality boundaries between Bentley and Larnook.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Des Mooney, said public feedback was being sought on the proposal to amend the address locality boundaries.

"Kyogle Council has advised some properties located on Boundary Creek Road in Larnook gain access to their properties through Bentley," Mr Mooney said.

"The council notes this is creating problems with the delivery of services due to difficulty in locating the properties."

Mr Mooney said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

"Residents are invited to view the proposed boundary amendment and lodge submissions with the Geographical Names Board," he said.
