PROPOSAL TO ASSIGN A RESERVE NAME

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Maitland City Council to name a reserve in Chisholm.

Secretary of the Geographical Names Board, Michael van den Bos, said feedback is being sought on the proposal to name the reserve bounded by Pondsitter Street and Dragonfly Drive, Dragonfly Park.

The name originates from the name of the road, Dragonfly Drive that bounds the reserve.

Mr van den Bos said “the Board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.”

“It is important that the name reflects the character and history of the local area and community,” he said.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name.”
