Proposal to assign an additional locality within Kosciuszko National Park – Blue Cow

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal to amend the advertised locality boundary of Guthega to allow for the creation of Blue Cow in the Kosciuszko National Park.

The proposal to formalise the locality names was advertised for public comment in January 2018. Based on the feedback received, the Board is now calling on comment for the inclusion of the locality of Blue Cow.

“An important element of determining place names and boundaries is to reflect local use,” said Mrs Narelle Underwood, Chair of the Geographical Names Board.

“So it can review community feedback the Board is encouraging community comment before it considers adopting the proposal,” she said.
