PROPOSAL TO CHANGE A GUNDAGAI LOCALITY NAME FROM JONES CREEK TO RENO

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Gundagai Shire Council to rename the locality of Jones Creek to Reno.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Des Mooney, said the Board is encouraging community comment before it considers adopting Council's proposal.

After receiving an application from local residents, Gundagai Shire Council resolved to submit the proposal to the Geographical Names Board.

The town of Reno was first proclaimed on 7 March 1879.

"It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community," Mr Mooney said.

"We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name."
