PROPOSAL TO AMEND BOUNDARIES IN LAKE MACQUARIE

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal to amend two locality boundaries in Lake Macquarie.

Board Chair, Narelle Underwood, said Lake Macquarie Council is proposing to amend the locality boundary between Windale and Jewells, and Mount Hutton and Eleebana. The proposed amendments reflect what the local residents are using.

“It is important that place names and boundaries reflect the character and history of the local area and community,” Ms Underwood said.

“All residents are invited to view the proposed boundary amendment and lodge submissions with the Geographical Names Board.”

A copy of map GNB3506-2-A showing the proposed locality boundary amendments will be on display at the Lake Macquarie City Council office located at 126-138 Main Road, Speers Point, NSW.
