### PROPOSAL TO NAME HOUSE GULLY

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Armidale Regional Council to name a gully, House Gully.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Narelle Underwood, said feedback is being sought on the proposal to name a gully in the locality of Enmore. It is located approximately 1.5kms south west of Mount Enmore, flowing westerly for approximately 3kms where it joins Grose Creek.

The proposed name is to commemorate the House family who have owned the property the gully flows through since 1887. The property has continually run cattle and sheep and the original wool shed still in use today was constructed in 1906.

Mrs Underwood said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community,” she said.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name.”
