PROPOSAL TO AMEND ADDRESS LOCALITY BOUNDARIES BETWEEN QUIDONG AND MERRIANGAAH

The Geographical Names Board has received a proposal from Bombala Council to amend the locality boundaries of Quidong and Merriangaah.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Des Mooney, said public feedback was being sought on the proposal to amend the locality boundaries.

“The proposal addresses the concerns of local residents that in an emergency event emergency vehicles will not find them or will be delayed,” Mr Mooney said.

Mr Mooney said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“Residents are invited to view the proposed boundary amendment and lodge submissions with the Geographical Names Board,” he said.
