### PROPOSED SUBURB BOUNDARY AMENDMENT IN THE LAKE MACQUARIE COUNCIL AREA

The Geographical Names Board (GNB) is seeking public comment on a proposal to change existing suburb boundaries within Lake Macquarie Local Government Area.

The proposal is to amend the suburb boundaries of New Lambton Heights and Cardiff Heights. It is proposed that the boundaries be amended so that all properties addressed to Currawong Road, Cardiff Heights will become a part of New Lambton Heights.

Lake Macquarie City Council has proposed the change due to Currawong Road being an isolated road with its only access coming from Marshall Street in New Lambton Heights.

“An important element of determining place names and boundaries is endeavouring to meet the approval of affected residents, and to reflect local usage and conditions,” said Mrs Narelle Underwood, Chair of the Geographical Names Board.

“So that it can consider feedback the Board is encouraging community comment before it considers adopting Council’s proposal,” she said.

Copies of map GNB3506-4-A showing the proposed suburb boundary amendment will be on display at Lake Macquarie City Council office located at 126-138 Main Road, Speers Point.
