PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO LOCALITY BOUNDARIES IN THE MOSMAN COUNCIL AREA

Mosman Council is proposing to amend address locality boundaries to recognise the four areas of Balmoral Beach, Beauty Point, Clifton Gardens and Mosman Bay as suburbs in their own right.

Residents seeking to use the names of the four suburbs as their official address, approached Council with the proposal initially.

Following a community consultation process, the Mosman Council then resolved to submit the proposal to the Geographical Names Board to recognise the four areas as suburbs.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Des Mooney, said the Board is encouraging community comment before it considers adopting Council's proposal.

"A map of the Council's proposal can be viewed at the Council Civic Centre in Mosman Square, Spit Junction, at the Mosman Library as well as online at the Mosman Council website - www.mosman.nsw.gov.au," Mr Mooney said.

"Residents are invited to view the proposed boundaries of Balmoral Beach, Beauty Point, Clifton Gardens and Mosman Bay and lodge submissions with the Geographical Names Board by Monday 18th November 2013."

The public has one month to respond to the Geographical Names Board.

Submissions on this proposal should be addressed in writing to the Secretary of the Geographical Names Board, Panorama Avenue, Bathurst 2795. Submissions can also be made online by visiting the Board's website (www.gnb.nsw.gov.au).

The closing date for submissions is Monday 18 November 2013. Further information can be accessed through the Board's website.
