PROPOSAL TO ASSIGN TWO RAILWAY STATION NAMES

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Transport for NSW to name two new railway stations.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Narelle Underwood, said feedback is being sought on the proposal to name *Kellyville Railway Station* and *Rouse Hill Railway Station*.

Kellyville Railway Station will be located on the corner of Samantha Riley Drive and Old Windsor Road, Kellyville. The station will be the primary public transport interchange for people living in Kellyville, Beaumont Hills and Stanhope Gardens.

Rouse Hill Railway Station will be located near the intersection of Main Street and Tempus Street, Rouse Hill. The station will be the primary public transport interchange located directly outside the Rouse Hill town centre and above the existing bus T-way, servicing a growing retail and entertainment centre.

Ms Underwood said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name,” said Ms Underwood.
