HAVE A SAY ON BOUNDARY AMENDMENT IN BYRON SHIRE LGA

The Geographical Names Board is calling for community comment on a proposal by Byron Shire Council to amend the address locality boundary between McLeods Shoot and Ewingsdale.

Currently residents in Wallaby Close at McLeods Shoot are experiencing difficulty with postal and courier services due to access to their properties from the locality of Ewingsdale.

The proposal is to change the boundary so Wallaby Close residents will be incorporated into the locality of Ewingsdale. This will support wayfinding to the properties.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board Narelle Underwood said feedback is being sought on the proposed change.

“An important element of determining boundaries is endeavouring to meet the approval of affected residents and to reflect local usage,” Mrs Underwood said.

A copy of the map GNB 3744-4A showing the proposed boundary amendment will be on display at Byron Shire Council Office at 70 Station Street in Mullumbimby from 28 August to 28 September 2019.
