HAVE YOUR SAY ON RESERVE NAMES IN THE CAMPBELLTOWN LGA

The Geographical Names Board is seeking community feedback on proposals to name two reserves in the suburb of Macquarie Links.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board Narelle Underwood said the Board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed names.”

Frank Bulluss Reserve is proposed for a reserve located between Macquarie Links Drive and Governors Way, in the suburb of Macquarie Links.

The late Frank Bulluss was one of the first owners to live in the estate, living opposite the proposed reserve and making a significant contribution to the development of the areas. A member of the Macquarie Links golf club within the estate, Bulluss was an avid supporter of the Royal Flying Doctor Service and organised an annual golf day each year, which raised \$187,000 over nine years.

Frank was a gifted runner, competing in the Stawell Gift and coaching winners of the famous race.

The proposal seeks to commemorate Bulluss’s contribution to the area’s development.

Links Reserve is proposed for a reserve located between Strathwallen Close and Barrack Circuit, in the suburb of Macquarie Links.

The name derives from Macquarie Links Estate and Golf Course and community paper, Links Newsletter. The reserve area links three stages of housing that extend to the golf course and is maintained by the Macquarie Links Community Association.
