HAVE YOUR SAY ON THE NAME OF A RESERVE IN THE CITY OF PARRAMATTA

The Geographical Names Board is seeking community feedback on a proposal by the City of Parramatta Council to name a reserve in the suburb of Lidcombe as *Kestrel Park*.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board Narelle Underwood is encouraging community comment on the proposal to name Kestrel Park.

“It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community,” she said.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name.”

The proposal recognises the Nankeen Kestrel, a small bird of prey recorded in the nearby Sydney Olympic Parklands.

The proposed name is consistent with other reserve names within the precinct (Osprey Park and Little Eagle Green) that complement nearby road names (Kingfisher Street and Honeyeater Street) and recognise the ecology of the surrounding area.
