PROPOSED BOUNDARY CHANGES WITHIN SHELLHARBOUR

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal to change existing locality boundaries within Shellharbour.

Board Chair, Narelle Underwood, said Shellharbour Council has proposed to amend the locality boundaries between Calderwood, North Macquarie and Tullimbar.

"Council is proposing to expand the locality of Calderwood to encompass North Macquarie and the northern part of Tullimbar," Ms Underwood said.

"Development in Calderwood will stretch into the proposed new boundary and the site has been known to the community as Calderwood or Calderwood Valley for the duration of its rejuvenation," she said.

"The Board is encouraging community comment before it considers adopting Council's proposal."

North Macquarie will be retained in the Geographical Names Register as a 'Rural Place'.

Copies of map GNB2535-3-A showing the proposed locality boundary amendment of Council's proposal will be on display at the Shellharbour Council's Administration Office, Lamerton Crescent, Shellharbour.

Ms Underwood said submissions should be lodged with the Geographical Names Board by Monday 14 November 2016.
