### **Proposal to assign four reserve names in the Shellharbour LGA**

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Shellharbour City Council to name four reserves.

The four reserves are located in the suburb of Flinders. Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Narelle Underwood said the names were chosen to be consistent with the local theme of naming reserves after adjoining road names and features of interest.

Bendoura Park, Jemima Reserve and Whittaker Reserve are named after adjoining road names. Sea Crest Reserve is named after the estate name 'Sea Crest Estate'.

Mrs Underwood said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers officially naming the reserves.

"We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed names," Mrs Underwood said.
