### HAVE YOUR SAY ON THE NAME OF A RESERVE IN CAMDEN LGA

The Geographical Names Board is seeking community feedback on a proposal by Camden Council to name a reserve in the suburb of Oran Park as *Dawson Damer Park*.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board Narelle Underwood is encouraging community comment on the proposal to name Dawson Damer Park.

“It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community,” she said.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name.”

The reserve is located northern side of Dick Johnson Drive, between Oran Park Drive and Dransfield Drive in the suburb of Oran Park, and seeks to commemorate the Hon. John Dawson-Damer, a former prominent motor racing identity and owner of the Oran Park homestead and stables.

Mr Dawson-Damer owned one of the world’s best private collection of Lotus racing cars.
