### **Proposed suburb boundary change in Lake Macquarie Local Government Area**

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Lake Macquarie City Council to amend the suburb boundary between Windermere Park and Morisset Park.

The proposal is to amend the boundary to allow all properties in Chifley Road to be in the one suburb, Morisset Park. This will ensure that the properties are easily identified and located.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Narelle Underwood said an important element of determining boundaries is endeavouring to meet the approval of affected residents and to reflect local usage.

“The Board is encouraging community comment before it considers adopting the proposal, so that it can consider all feedback,” Mrs Underwood said.

A copy of map 3506-5-A, showing the proposed boundary amendment will be on display at Lake Macquarie City Council office located at 126-138 Main Road, Speers Point.
