HAVE YOUR SAY ON THE NAME OF A RESERVE IN SHELLHARBOUR CITY COUNCIL LGA

The Geographical Names Board is seeking community feedback on a proposal by Shellharbour City Council to name a reserve in the suburb of Albion Park as *Bubara View Park*.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board Narelle Underwood said community comment is being sought on the proposal to name *Bubara View Park*.

“It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community,” she said.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name.”

Bubara is the word for mountain in the local Dharawal language.

The park is located on the corner of Crest Road and Upland Chase with the proposed name reflecting the surrounding mountain views.
