### HAVE YOUR SAY ON THE NAME OF CIVIC PLACE NAME IN BURWOOD LGA

The Geographical Names Board is seeking community feedback on a proposal by Burwood Council to name a civic place in the suburb of Burwood as Unity Place.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board Narelle Underwood said the Board is encouraging community comment on the proposal to name a section of Hornsey Lane that has been redesigned into a pedestrian space.

“It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community,” she said.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name.”

The pedestrian space runs between Wynne Avenue and Conder Street behind the Burwood Council and Library Building.

The proposed name, Unity, represents values of community, respect and kindness, and signifies that Burwood is a connected and harmonious community.

The name received the highest number of votes in Council’s “Name the Lane” community competition.
