## HAVE YOUR SAY ON A PLACE NAME IN HORNSBY LGA

The Geographical Names Board is seeking community feedback on a proposal by NSW National Parks and Wildlife Service to name a lookout in the suburb of Berowra Heights as *Barnetts Lookout*.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board Narelle Underwood said the Board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community,” she said.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name.”

The lookout is located within the Berowra Valley National Park and is accessed via Barnetts Road. It offers views across the Berowra Valley and the waters of Berowra Creek.
