HAVE YOUR SAY ON A PLACE NAME IN MID-COAST LGA

The Geographical Names Board is seeking community feedback on a proposal by NSW National Park and Wildlife Service to name a lookout in the suburb of Gloucester Tops as *Andrew Laurie Lookout*.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board Narelle Underwood said the Board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community,” Mrs Underwood said.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name.”

Andrew Laurie Lookout is located within the Barrington Tops National Park situated along the Gloucester Falls walking track.

The lookout is surrounded by woodlands and snow gums with views over the Gloucester River and across to the Mountaineer peak.
