HAVE YOUR SAY ON A PLACE NAME IN PORT MACQUARIE-HASTINGS LGA

The Geographical Names Board is seeking community feedback on a proposal by National Parks and Wildlife Service (NPWS) to rename Hamey Lookout in the suburb of Camden Head as *Charles Hamey Lookout*.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board Narelle Underwood said the Board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name,” Mrs Underwood said.

“It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community.”

The lookout is located at the end of Charles Hamey Lookout Road, in Kattang Nature Reserve and sits on a cliff top, providing visitors with coastal views.

The lookout is currently gazetted as Hamey Lookout; however, signage and publications use the name Charles Hamey Reserve.
