### **Proposed suburb boundary change in Goulburn Mulwaree Local Government Area**

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Goulburn Mulwaree Council to amend the address locality boundary between Tarago and Lake Bathurst.

The proposal is to amend the boundary so all properties in Mulwaree Street will be located in Tarago. This will ensure the properties are easily identified and located.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Narelle Underwood said an important element of determining boundaries is endeavouring to meet the approval of affected residents and to reflect local usage.

“The Board is encouraging community comment before it considers adopting the proposal, so that it can consider all feedback,” Mrs Underwood said.

A copy of map 3753-3-A, showing the proposed boundary amendment will be on display at the Goulburn Mulwaree Civic Centre, 184-194 Bourke Street, Goulburn from 12 April to 12 May 2019.
