### **HAVE A SAY ON PROPOSED BOUNDARY AMENDMENT IN PORT MACQUARIE-HASTINGS LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA**

The Geographical Names Board is calling for community members to comment on a proposal by Port Macquarie-Hastings Council to amend the locality boundary between Hacks Ferry and Limeburners Creek.

Hacks Ferry residents on the eastern side of the Maria River are currently isolated from the western portion of the locality, gaining access to their properties from Limeburners Creek.

The proposal is to change the locality boundary so the portion of Hacks Ferry on the eastern side of Maria River is incorporated into the locality of Limeburners Creek.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board Narelle Underwood said: "An important element of determining the boundaries is to seek approval of affected residents and reflect the local usage.

"We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed amendment."

Details of the map showing the proposed boundary amendment will be on display at Port Macquarie-Hastings Council Administration Building at 17 Burrawan Street in Port Macquarie from 28 August to 28 September 2019.
