### **Proposal to assign a reserve name**

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Shellharbour City Council to name a reserve in Warilla.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Narelle Underwood, said feedback is being sought on the proposal to name the site in Harvey Street, *Fryer Park*.

The name commemorates William Fryer who served as Mayor of Shellharbour Municipality from 1867 to 1870. The reserve has been known locally as *Fryer Park* for nearly 50 years however has not been formally assigned.

Mrs Underwood said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name.”
