Proposal to assign a reserve name in Bohnock

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Mid-Coast Council to name a reserve in Bohnock.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Narelle Underwood said feedback is being sought on the proposal to officially name the site at Channel Close, Bohnock, as Bohnock Reserve.

The reserve takes its name from the locality in which it is situated. The park has been known locally as *Bohnock Reserve*.

Mrs Underwood said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community,” Mrs Underwood said.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name.”
