### HAVE A SAY ON NAMING THREE RESERVES IN CAMDEN

The Geographical Names Board is calling for community comment on a proposal by Camden Council name three reserves in the local area.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board Narelle Underwood said feedback is being sought on the proposal to name the reserves as Camden South Rotary Park, Forest Reserve and Montgomery Reserve.

Camden South Rotary Park is located next to the Old Hume Highway, between Cowper Drive and Reeve Place in Camden South. The reserve is named after the Rotary Club and was developed as a community service project from 1968 to 1983.

Forest Reserve is bounded by Glenrowan Drive and Rhodes Place, in Harrington Park. The name reflects the treed nature of the reserve.

Montgomery Reserve is bounded by Montgomery Circuit and Winston Place, in Narellan Vale. The name is derived from the adjoining road Montgomery Circuit.

Mrs Underwood said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name,” Mrs Underwood said.
