Proposal to assign a reserve name – Coronation Park

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Walgett Shire Council to name a reserve in Burren Junction.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Narelle Underwood, said feedback is being sought on the proposal to name the site on the corner of Hastings and Waterloo Streets as *Coronation Park*.

The name commemorates the former Coronation Hotel that once stood on the land.

Mrs Underwood said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community,” she said.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name.”
