Proposal to assign a reserve name – Louisa Park

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Mid-Western Regional Council to name a reserve in Hargraves.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Narelle Underwood, said feedback is being sought on the proposal to name the site on the corner of Merinda Street, Scotts-Hill Street and Gundowda Road, as *Louisa Park*.

The area was known in the early 1800s as Louisa Goldfields and Louisa Creek runs nearby.

Mrs Underwood said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community,” she said.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name.”
