HAVE YOUR SAY ON THE NAME OF A RESERVE IN LANE COVE LGA

The Geographical Names Board is seeking community feedback on a proposal by Lane Cove Council to name a reserve in the suburb of Lane Cove North as *Djanaba Park*.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board Narelle Underwood said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

"It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community," she said.

"We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name."

The new reserve is located at 552 Mowbray Road West, Lane Cove North and is designed to cater for the immediate local community.

It will provide space for passive activities, a small area for play incorporating a nature-based theme, an interactive play sculpture and a BBQ with accessible seating.

The word 'Djanaba' means laughter in the Cammeraygal language.
