PROPOSAL TO AMEND LOCALITY BOUNDARIES IN KYOGLE

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Kyogle Council to amend the localities of Bentley and Larnook.

Council is proposing to amend the address locality boundaries as residents currently located in Larnook gain access to their properties through Bentley. This is creating problems for the delivery of services due to difficulty in locating the properties.

The proposed boundary amendment will result in the affected properties changing their address from Larnook to Bentley.

Mr Mooney said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed changes,” he said.
