## Proposal to assign a civic place name

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by City of Sydney Council to name a civic place in Sydney.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Narelle Underwood, said feedback is being sought on the proposal to name the site bounded by Kent, Sussex and Napoleon Streets, Napoleon Plaza.

The site provides a pedestrian link between Wynyard Walk and the business precinct of Barangaroo. The proposed name Napoleon Plaza was selected due to its proximity to the adjacent Napoleon Street and Napoleon Bridge.

Mrs Underwood said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

"It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community," she said.

"We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name."
