Proposal to assign a reserve name

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Randwick City Council to name a reserve in Randwick.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Narelle Underwood said feedback is being sought on the proposal to name the site at Young Street, as *Inglis Park*.

The reserve is being created as part of the Newmarket residential development. The proposed name seeks to commemorate the historic use and former land owners of the site. The Inglis family leased the Newmarket Stables from 1906, later purchasing the complex. The family played a vital role in Australian racing history with Inglis and Sons operating at the site for 112 years.

Mrs Underwood said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community,” Mrs Underwood said.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name.”
