HAVE A SAY ON NAME OF RESERVE IN KU-RING-GAI LGA

The Geographical Names Board is calling for community feedback on a proposal by Ku-ring-gai Council to name a reserve in Turramurra as Boyds Orchard Park.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board Narelle Underwood said feedback is being sought on the proposal to name the site located on the corner of Duff Street, Allan Avenue and Holmes Street in the locality of Turramurra

“Community feedback is a vital part of the process when a name is being considered,” Mrs Underwood said.

“Boyds Orchard has been recommended because it reflects the character and history of the local area, which in 1893 was used for orchards.”
