HAVE YOUR SAY ON THE NAME OF A CREEK IN THE BLUE MOUNTAINS LGA

The Geographical Names Board is seeking community feedback on a proposal to name a creek in Blaxland and Glenbrook.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board Narelle Underwood said feedback is being sought on the proposal to:

- rename the section of Lapstone Creek extending east from Glenbrook Lagoon, to just north of Lennox Bridge as Brookside Creek, and;
- name the currently un-named section from just north of Lennox Bridge that runs west, adjacent to Mitchells Pass as Lapstone Creek.

The name Brookside references a former property near where the creek flows.

Mrs Underwood said the Board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community,” she said.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name.”
