PROPOSAL TO AMEND BOUNDARY WITHIN CUMBERLAND

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal to amend a locality boundary in Cumberland.

Board Chair Narelle Underwood said Cumberland Council has submitted a proposal to amend the locality boundary between Holroyd and Merrylands.

“The change would allow the ‘Neil Street Precinct’ to be wholly within one locality,” Ms Underwood said.

“The Board is encouraging community comment before it considers adopting council’s proposal.”

A copy of map GNB5855-1-A showing the proposed locality boundary change will be on display at Cumberland Council 16 Memorial Ave, Merrylands, NSW.
