PROPOSAL TO ASSIGN A RAILWAY STATION NAME

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Transport for NSW to name a new railway station in Cherrybrook.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Narelle Underwood, said feedback is being sought on the proposal to name the station on Castle Hill Road, between Franklin Road and Robert Road, as *Cherrybrook Railway Station*.

The station will be the primary public transport interchange serving residential areas including Cherrybrook, West Pennant Hills and Dural.

Ms Underwood said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name,” said Ms Underwood.
