**PROPOSAL TO RENAME WYONG REGIONAL SPORTING
COMPLEX
TO CENTRAL COAST HOCKEY PARK**

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by the Central Coast Council to name a reserve in Wyong.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Narelle Underwood, said feedback is being sought on the proposal to rename the site located at 375-385 Pacific Highway, *Central Coast Hockey Park*. The site is currently named Wyong Regional Sporting Complex.

Council has proposed the name *Central Coast Hockey Park* to accurately reflect the use of the site. The reserve has a number of hockey fields that are used and operated by the Central Coast Hockey Association. A large part of the reserve is also classified as a conservation area.

Mrs Underwood said the Board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community,” she said.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name.”
