Proposal to assign a reserve name in East Gosford

The Geographical Names Board is calling for public comment on a proposal by Central Coast Council to name a reserve in East Gosford.

Chair of the Geographical Names Board, Narelle Underwood said feedback is being sought on the proposal to name the site East Gosford Community Reserve, which is bound by Wells Street and Waratah Street.

The name reflects the location of the reserve in East Gosford and its links to the local community, who actively campaigned to save the park.

Mrs Underwood said the board is encouraging community comment before it considers the proposal.

“It is important that place names reflect the character and history of the local area and community,” Mrs Underwood said.

“We want to make sure everyone has an opportunity to provide their feedback on the proposed name.”
